A Public Hearing held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, February 3, 2025, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

Roll Call - Aldermen Brown, Dorchinecz, Olive and Wilson were present. Alderman Bryant, Driskell, Mitchelson and Skultety were absent.

Mayor Barry, City Clerk Richardson, Lisa Sassatelli, Jim Morris, and Matt Hart were also in attendance. Attorney Romano was present via Zoom.

Mayor Barry announced that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to consider an Ordinance making an Amendment to the City of Taylorville Ordinance No. 3913 dated September 16, 2019, and the City of Taylorville Ordinance No. 4238 dated April 1, 2024, to add the Village of Edinburg and the Village of Stonington and Territory to the Taylorville – Christian County Enterprise Zone and Amending the Intergovernmental Agreement.

The Mayor asked if there were any written responses to any City Officials and there were none. He asked if anyone from the public would like to address the Council, no one present spoke.
